

## **FGC Operational Railway Safety Policy**

## 1) General principles of action

The members of the FGC Steering Committee adopt the following general principles of action:

- 1. Application of a Safety Management System based on the business mission of keeping railway operations operational, safely, with total responsibility and transparency in safety management.
- 2. Commitment that any worker related to Railway Safety has access to the regulatory documents in their area of responsibility.
- 3. Establishment of accident supervision and investigation measures, for the evaluation and management of railway risks.
- 4. Commitment to the management of the human and organizational factor.
- 5. Promotion of safety culture.

## 2) Guarantee of commitment to safety

FGC, through its Steering Committee, approves the following measures to guarantee its commitment to safety:

- 1. When making management decisions, safety will prevail over any other interest of the company.
- 2. Carry out periodic reviews and audits of the Safety Management System to establish continuous improvement programs.
- 3. Permanently improve processes related to Railway Safety, eliminating or mitigating the factors that cause risks.
- 4. Communicate the Safety Policy to all FGC staff and FGC's supplier companies.

## 3) Management criteria

The FGC Railway Safety Management System considers the following management criteria:

- 1. Provision of Safety Objectives and monitoring of their compliance and permanent review through different surveillance processes.
- 2. Establishment of both upward and downward communication channels, both internal and external, so that communication is accurate, reliable and bidirectional.
- 3. Provision of the necessary means, both human and material, so that there is adequate training for all people with functions related to Railway Safety.
- 4. Obligation to respect all legal and regulatory requirements, both on the part of FGC and the supplier companies that provide services.
- 5. Obligation to control and manage risks.
- 6. Alignment of the Safety Policy with FGC's strategic plan to maintain continuous improvement of railway safety results.
